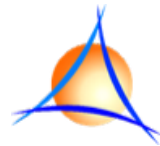

THE MFUC MASTER SCHOLARSHIP AND THE ISDB SCHOLARSHIP

4 students were awarded the MFUC Master scholarship: the programme supported by the French Embassy in Malaysia and implemented by MFUC supports the mobility of Malaysian Master students to French Universities. The scholarship represents an allowance of 900 euros per month.

2 students were awarded the scholarship from the Islamic Development Bank (IsDB) – Campus France: The programme launched in June 2020 benefits from the financial and/or logistical support from the IsDB, Campus France, the Embassy of France in Malaysia and MFUC (700 euros per month + social coverage). Both recipients will receive an allowance covering a full cycle of study at bachelor or master level.
